# **Program Details**

Day 01
Arrive Jaipur

Arrive Jaipur. On arrival, you will be greeted and assisted by our representative and transferred to the hotel. (Rooms will be blocked from previous night in order to facilitate check in on immediate occupancy).

JAIPUR - The fascinating capital of the marvellous state of Rajasthan.

Jaipur is popularly known as the Pink City, thanks to the colour of its buildings. It was built in 1727 A.D by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, followed a grid system, which made it the only planned city of its time. A young Bengali architect Vidhyadhar Bhattacharya designed the city in accordance with Shilp Shastra - an ancient Hindu treatise on architecture. There are innumerable sagas and stories of culture, traditions, practices and valour. This diverse land of rich cultural heritage is a royal treat for tourists all over the world.

On arrival in Jaipur, transfer to hotel.

After breakfast, morning is at leisure to relax in the beautiful The Oberoi Rajvilas to get rid of Jet lag.

In the afternoon enjoy exclusive Yoga session at the hotel.

In the evening, we welcome you to India. Feel like a Maharaja's (Kings) and Maharani's (Queens) of the gone era as we take you on a wonderful evening on a **Grand Royal Procession at The Oberoi Rajvilas followed by cultural performance and Dinner.** 

This is a majestic welcome in true Royal Rajasthani style. As the guests disembark at the entrance to the hotel, they are welcomed by "Kachi Ghori", a traditional Rajasthani dance. Walking towards the entrance to the lobby, beautifully adorned camels, elephants and horses stand at attention, regaling the guests as they used to for the Indian kings of yore. Elegantly ladies, dressed in traditional Rajasthani outfits shower rose petals while musicians at the entrance Chatris play lilting tunes from Rajasthani classical instruments. This majestic scene is completed with garlands, aarti and tika welcome.



Later enjoy the Welcome Dinner along with free flow of Beer / Liquor (Indian made foreign liquor) for 02 hrs.

Day 02

After a leisurely breakfast, enjoy shopping tour with guides.

Enjoy visit of block printing workshop and Gem stone workshop during.

Later in the evening, enjoy cultural night at Dera Amer.

On arrival at Dera Amer indulge in the wonders of Rajasthani culture and spectacular experiences.

On arrival, you will be welcome by Bagpiper Band to Dera Amer. On arrival, enjoy the welcome drinks while enjoy bagpiper music is still floating through the air. After the welcome drink, group will be divided in two parts and doing the Elephant ride and Camel Polo on rotation basis. Further a village theme is set up for you including Henna, Astrologer, Puppet Show, Magician etc.

Simultaneously enjoy the drinks at Open Bar (Beer / Indian made foreign liquor)

After these activities, enjoy a barbeque Dinner.

After Dinner at Dera Amer, drive back to the hotel.

Day 03

**Jaipur** 

Early morning enjoy hot air balloon ride in Jaipur.

**Passenger Pick-up and Drop:** Passengers will be picked-up from their hotel /accommodation approximately 45 minutes before the flight (dependant on the distance between the hotel and launch site). Passengers will be notified of the exact pick-up time 24 hours before their flight. (Reporting time at Launch site: approx 0645 hrs)



**Passenger Briefing and Tea/Coffee:** Once passengers arrive at the launch site the pilot will give a safety briefing and basic orientation to the technical aspects of Hot-Air Ballooning.

Tea/Coffee, cold drinks and cookies are served during the inflation of the balloon.

**Flight:** Flight time is approximately 60 minutes (+/- 10 minutes). Bottled mineral water is available during the flight.

**Post flight Activities:** After the balloon has landed, passengers can stay for as little or as long as they like until they are ready to leave the landing site to be driven back to their hotel. The pilot will hand out First Flight certificates to all passengers as a memento of their experience.

**Total Ballooning experience:** Approximately 3 hours.

## Also note few important details regarding balloon ride:

- There is no upper age limit; passengers must be able to stand for at-least one hour. Children must be at least 6 years of age and 1.5 m tall (to see over the sides of basket)..
- If you have a disability, medical condition or have recently undergone a surgery, it's best to check with
  your doctor to ensure you're fit to fly. However, we're unable to fly anyone who is confined to a
  wheelchair. It is very important that you disclose any medical or physical condition that could be
  considered to affect your safety or the safety of others. You must not fly if you are under the influence of
  alcohol or drugs

After the balloon ride experience, drive back to the hotel.

Later in the afternoon enjoy Rickshaw Ride in Old part of Jaipur.

It takes you through the narrow by lanes of Jaipur, through the hussle & Bustle of the Old bazzare (Market). The humble cycle rickshaw is not only the common man's beast o the burden, but it also serves to generate considerable employment. Most of all however, in an age when our cities are beset by the pollution menace of the automobile, it provides perhaps the only viable alternative for the short haul (say, 5 kms). However in the present context we shall offer this ride as a nostalgic trip.

## Day 04

## Jaipur / Udaipur (Flight) / Devigarh (Approx 38 Kms / 01 1/2 hr)

After breakfast, drive to airport to board flight for Udaipur.

UDAIPUR - The "City of Lakes" was founded in 1559 AD as capital town of the former Mewar state by Maharana Udai Singh on the eastern banks of the Lake Pichola. The rich cultural, social and natural heritage, aesthetic beauty and ecological richness, so far preserved through the surrounding lakes, serene and opulent hilly range of the Aravalis and lush green vegetation and pleasant gardens and harmonious built forms present a unique condition of scenic beauty. The magical beauty of Lake Pichola allures the visitors again and again.

Its historical monuments in the forms of Palaces, Havelis & Temples surrounded by the hills and a pleasant bracing climate have favored its growth from a small princely town to an important tourist destination.

On arrival in Udaipur, drive to Devigarh.

In the evening enjoy a nice cocktail for 02 hrs to enjoy the sunset view.

Hosted dinner.

Overnight at the hotel.

#### Day 05

Devigarh / Udaipur / Devigarh (Approx 28 Kms / 01 hr one way)

After breakfast morning is at leisure.

## Wake up the Little Chef in you....

In the afternoon, we will split the group into 07 teams by the team captains, typically through a schoolyard pick. Once the teams are divided, each team will be given clues to find their cooking essential secretly placed in the hotel. Once the teams have their essentials ready, each team then will be given a cooking station with all the essentials. Two Teams will be assisted by the Chef and overlooked by "Executive Chef". DELHI - It is a city that bridges two different worlds. Old Delhi, once the capital of Islamic India, is a labyrinth of narrow lanes lined with crumbling havelis and formidable mosques. In contrast, the imperial city of New Delhi created by the British Raj is composed of spacious, tree-lined avenues and imposing government buildings. Delhi has been the seat of power for several rulers and many empires for about a millennium. Many a times the city was built, destroyed and then rebuilt here. Interestingly, a number of Delhi's rulers played a dual role, first as destroyers and then as creators.

On arrival, enjoy a visit of Gandhi Museum.

**The Gandhi Museum** has a very rich collection of original relics, books, journals and documents, photographs, audio-visual materials, exhibitions, art pieces and other memorabilia closely connected with Mahatma Gandhi, Kastur Ba and Indian Freedom Struggle. It is developing into a Resource Centre for the Gandhian and allied Studies and Research. It also processes the information, data, audio-visual materials, etc., for the use of different categories.
